During the summer months, significant investment has been made in the school's ICT network, with **fibre optic cabling** installed and switches upgraded to gigabit quality.

The broadband system has been upgraded, and the school now has a single **'Enterprise Class' WiFi** system with ac speeds, that can handle multiple (100) connections from any point.

The **LCA and Guidance Rooms** have been fitted with student computer work stations. This is the first phase of a development which we hope to roll out throughout the school.

The **Community Room (Room 33)** has been fitted with a new kitchen, and further refurbishment is planned here. I hope that you will enjoy the Community Room improvements, by signing up to some of the great courses run by HSCL.
